

His Indenture witnesseth

that Mary Douglas daughter of James Douglas of Rochester her mother late put
her selfe Appointed to William Andrews of Milton next Gravesend in Kent Taylor
Printer and Binderman with mey after the maner of an Apprenticed to bind from
the day of this date of these presents unto the full end and termes of
seven years from thence unto during fully to be compleat and ended during
which termes the said Appointed shall & do Master faithfully shall and will bind
his Appointees bddp his lawfull Commande whiche gladdly doo. he shall do no
damagē to her said Master nor selle it to bddp of others but to her powre shall
let or forthwith givē & notisē to her said Master of the same the goods of her said
Master he shall not waste nor the same without lycence of him to any givē or lende
lent to her said Master she shall not doe tansē or prouide to bddp of others she shall
not indeuy nor sell without her Masters lycence, Tawdryes, Tunes, or Aldhousess.
she shall not haue at Cards, dice, Tabloes, or any other unlawfull Gamesshe shall
not play, nor from
the bddp of her said Master day nor night absente her selfe but in all things
as an honest and fauill Appointed shall and will demean & behau her
selfe towards her said Master and all his during the said termes And the said
Master his said Appointed in the art mistery or occupation of Rethorice & Good
conservacie which he now useth shall teach and instruct, or tansē to bddp taught
instructed the best way and maner that he can findinge al necessarye to his said
Appointed sufficient reholtion meate and apparel wastynge & dredging eale
other necessarie during his said termes and in the end thereof to have the summe
of a paard for all parts of his body. (that is to say) one for wearynge dres
and keper for hys daies fit for her wearynge
And for the said performance of all and every the said Obedience and agreements
dithde of the said parties abovesaid bindeth him selfe unto the oþer fyrmyly by these
presentes In witness whiche of the said parties to this Indenture Interchangably haue
gþt their hands and sealys this daye of January in the
year of the Raigne of our deigne Lady Anne
by the grace of God of Great Britain, France, Ireland, & her Despoules of y' faith
